Communication Committee Meeting Minutes Thursday, January 30, 2020 District Board Room 5:30 p.m.

Chair Jennifer Malueg called the meeting to order.

Dr. Garvey verified that the meeting was properly posted.

Motion by Siewert/Malueg to adopt the agenda as posted. Motion Carried.

On Board President Rick Wrensch's behalf, Dr. Garvey presented the ideas of replacing the Administrative reports at the Board meetings with student spotlights. The Administrators would provide their reports in writing giving the Board an opportunity to ask questions or comment at the meeting. The Committee endorsed the idea of adding student spotlights. There was not as much support, from the Board members present at the meeting, for eliminating the oral reports from the Administrators.

Dr. Garvey again proposed joining Alumni Nations.

At the last meeting the Committee tabled this item until after the WASB convention so that more information could be gathered. Mrs. Kolaske had agreed to investigate.

Dr. Garvey shared how connecting with alums can provide fundraising monies, develop communications with alumni (connecting), develop a volunteer corps, and identify field trips and youth apprenticeship opportunities, etc.

Mrs. Kolaske was unable to attend the meeting but sent a text opposing this proposal stating it appeared to her that it was just a way to fundraise for the fields, which she does not feel supports student instruction.

Dr. Garvey reminded the Committee about the many uses of the Alumni data. He also reminded the Committee that even if the data is only used for fundraising the Board has a responsibility to complete the fundraising projects. He also reminded the Committee how important our extracurricular activities are to the education of our students.

Motion by Malueg/Siewert to recommend to the Board that the District enter into a contract with Alumni Nations. Motion Carried.
