Admission of Adult Students

POLICY: 423

Any adult resident of the School District of Johnson Creek may be admitted to school, for enrichment purposes or to further their academic skills, provided the following requirements have been met:

- 1. The applicant shall make a written request to be admitted and list the courses desired.
- 2. Participation by the adult must not interfere with the education of students of school age.
- 3. There must be available space and materials in the class desired.
- 4. Any fees must be paid in advance of taking the course(s).
- 5. Any adult student must abide by all school rules as outlined in a current copy of the Student Handbook unless certain specified exceptions are made by the administration.
- 6. Adult students will arrive at school just prior to the time of their class and leave after class unless they have other business at the school.
