

Student Representative to the Board of Education

In an effort to involve students in the process of governance of the school district, the Board of Education shall establish the position of student representative to the Board of Education. A student from the high school shall have the opportunity to sit with the Johnson Creek Board of Education at its regular monthly meeting to represent the interests of the student body. The student should be invited to attend all open sessions, would receive all non-confidential materials sent to Board members, and could participate in the discussions regarding district business at those meetings. He/she would not be able to vote or make motions. The student representative will be selected by the MS/HS principal and District Administrator.
