

### **Safety Program**

The Board of Education will take every reasonable precaution to protect the safety of students, employees, and other citizens present on district property or at school-sponsored events.

The Board will comply with all safety requirements established by governmental authorities and will insist that its staff adhere to these safety practices as these pertain to the school plant, special areas of instruction, student transportation, school athletics, and other areas of curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activities.

The practice of safety also will be considered a facet of the educational program of Johnson Creek Elementary and MS/HS. Instruction in accident prevention, fire prevention, and emergency procedures will be provided in appropriate grades and classes.

Principals will be responsible for the supervision of a safety program for their schools. However, the district administrator will have overall responsibility for the safety program of the district. It will be the ultimate responsibility of the district administrator to see that staff members are kept informed of pertinent state and local regulations and recommendations relating to safety in schools.
