

School District Legal Status

The legal basis for public education in the School District is vested in the will of the people as expressed in the Wisconsin Constitution. Public education is primarily a state responsibility and a local school district's function.

The official name of this school district is the "School District of Johnson Creek". It is classified as a common school district and includes the Village of Johnson Creek and portions of the towns of Watertown, Farmington, Aztalan, Milford and Concord.

Educational services of the District shall be organized as a program of instruction for PK through 12. The District shall be operated as a single system by the Superintendent, under the direction of the Board of Education.
