Chair Richard Wensch called the meeting to order.

Members Present were: Carol O'Neil, Andrew Swanson, Richard Wensch, Principals Kristine Blakeley and Cale Vogel, Director of Teaching & Learning Lisa Krohn, and Superintendent Michael Garvey

Also Present: Elementary teacher Sam Hett, Middle School teacher Megan Rojemann, and High School teacher Eric Rojemann

Dr. Garvey verified that the meeting was properly posted.

Motion by O'Neil/Swanson to adopt the agenda as posted. Motion carried.

Elementary teacher Sam Hett presented the instructional strategies being used at the elementary level for mathematics emphasizing the individual nature and increased problem solving. A variety of strategies have replaced textbooks.

Middle school teacher Megan Rojemann presented the instructional strategies being used at the middle school level of mathematics emphasizing individual levels, increased problem solving, and use of groups. The change to 90 minute periods has helped facilitate the instruction.

High school teacher Eric Rojemann presented the instructional strategies and curriculum changes at the high school level. The biggest change is the switch to Integrated Math. The changes have the greatest affect on current 10th graders. Eric presented documents showing the integrated course work.

Mrs. Krohn presented proficiency reports which will ultimately replace the report cards in grades K-8. The student reports will indicate proficiency based upon a student's level versus age.

Mr. Wensch left at 9:45 a.m.

The Committee discussed the proficiency reports in great length and looked at examples.

Motion by Swanson/O'Neil to adjourn. Motion carried.
