**General Fees**

**Grades Pre K-12.....\$25/student**

The general materials fees are used to help defray the cost of materials used in the regular operation of classes.

Some classes will require outside projects for which parents will provide the necessary supplies. For example:  
an elementary social studies project, a middle school science fair project, a Spanish dish for Spanish class, etc.  
Classroom teachers will communicate this to you.

High school classes in technology education and art will require additional fees when class projects are differentiated.

**Elementary (K-4).....\$4.05/day**  
**Middle (5-8).....\$4.15/day**  
**High (9-12).....\$4.25/day**  
**Adults .....\$5.25/day**  
**Reduced fee Lunch.....\$0.40/day**  
**Extra ½ pint of milk.....\$0.50**

**Elementary (K-4).....\$2.30/day**  
**Middle (5-8).....\$2.40/day**

**Athletic Fees**

**Grades 9-12:               \$50/sport per child (includes Powerlifting)**  
**Grades 6-8:               \$30/sport per child except football**  
**7/8<sup>th</sup> grade football:   \$50/child**

The athletic fees are used to help defray the cost of materials used in the regular operation of the sport.

Some programs will offer “sports packages” which include uniform/apparel that is personal in nature at an additional cost (e.g. football girdles, practice jerseys, etc.). The coaching staff will communicate these offers to you. These are not included in the athletic fees.
