

Staff Involvement in Decision Making

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education to encourage the district administrator to invite participation in decision making for the school district. The district administrator is authorized to establish such committees as necessary to recommend policies and rules for the proper functioning of the district.

In the development of policies, rules, regulations, and arrangements for the operation of the school system, the district administrator shall include at the planning stage, whenever feasible, those employees who will be affected by such provisions.

The district administrator, with professional and classified employees, shall develop and maintain channels for the ready intercommunication of ideas and feelings regarding the operation of the schools.
