Lake Mills, WI – The Johnson Creek High School Cross Country team enjoyed Friday night lights with steep competition at the Lake Mills Golf Course for the Nightfall Classic meet, boasting over 1,200 entrants, races split by sex and division. Freshman Lauren Nadboralski brought home a medal, crossing the line in twentieth place with a time of 21 minutes, 16.06 seconds.

Coach Ben Hail said, "Nightfall is a favorite event for many of the athletes. With it being such a large event and the atmosphere of a championship race, there is plenty of competition and high-level racing. Our kids raced well under the lights and many of them ran really close to lifetime best times on a challenging course.
